The war in Ukraine poses a number of challenges for Ukrainian society and the rest of the world: How can the potential and resilience of civil society actors be strengthened? What do civil society organizations need in order to build stable structures and professionalize them? What are the conditions for success for a secure future perspective for civil society - especially in times of parallel challenges posed by the Russian war of aggression, EU rapprochement, reconstruction and modernization?

The study trip offers an intensive exchange and the creation of networks both within Ukraine and with European experts. The aim is to sustainably strengthen the agency and resilience of civil society actors and to develop a vision of an empowered and well-networked post-war Ukraine.
